How to Complete the New Alberta Livestock Manifest



Part A - Purpose of Manifest

- Livestock manifests can be used for transport only or for transport for sale.
- The box for "Transport Only" or one of the boxes for "Transport for Sale" must be checked off.
- If a separate livestock security interest declaration is being provided, the box on the second row of Part A must be checked off.





Copies of the livestock manifest have to be retained by the owner of the livestock, the livestock dealer, the transporter and the destination for 10 years.

Part B - Transportation and Sale Details

- Livestock can only be transported in the name of the owner of the livestock or a livestock dealer acting on behalf of the owner.
- Feeder Association livestock are to be transported in the name of the feeder association on account of the member.
- Parts A and B of the livestock manifest may be completed by the owner or the owner's agent.
- If the destination changes, the new destination must be recorded on all copies of the livestock manifest.

Part C - Parts A and B Certification

- Part C must be signed by the owner of the livestock if the livestock manifest does not direct payment solely to the owner of the livestock. However, a livestock dealer acting on behalf of the owner may sign Part C if the livestock manifest directs payment to that livestock dealer.
- The feeder association member is an owner for the purpose of signing Part C.
- Parts A, B and C must be completed before the livestock is transported.
- The "Head Office" (white), "Livestock Inspector" (blue), "Transporter" (green) and "Destination" (white) copies of the livestock manifest must accompany the livestock to their destination.

- Transporter

person transporting the livestock must plete Part E, provide the "Head Office", vestock Inspector" and "Destination" copies of livestock manifest to the person receiving the stock at the destination and retain the ansporter" copy.

- Livestock Security Interest Declaration

en livestock is transported for sale, the <u>owner</u> st complete, sign and date Part F <u>unless</u> the ner provides a completed livestock security erest declaration by a separate form.

ne livestock is transported for sale by a estock dealer on behalf of the owner, Part F ot completed as the owner is required to vide the declaration to the livestock dealer.

nere is a livestock security interest in the stock or the dam of the livestock, the sale ceeds are required to be paid to the owner and holder of the livestock security interest. The sale ceeds are then used to pay off the loan secured the livestock.

- Destination

person receiving the livestock must complete G of the livestock manifest.

ne livestock is required to be inspected at destination, the "Head Office", "Livestock pector" and "Destination" copies of the estock manifest are to be provided to the stock inspector.
